My Meal Ticket!

This full-time restaurant manager's philosophy was "2 for me, 1 for you."

She stole for nearly 4 of the 10 years she worked for her company (part of a nationwide chain). She was distraught after the interrogation and asked that her confession be typed as she gave it. A witness was brought in who listened and typed up her 'word-for-word' confession.

Watch her right hand carefully in the video. She crumples up an undetermined amount of bills and conceals them in an envelope to her right. She was later interrogated, and the confession explains the rest of the story. At no time was she ever told there was video evidence because to do so would have...

(Full-time restaurant cashier - Nationwide chain.)

I have Work For 10 years.

Over the last 3 ya years I have stealing stealing.

I have Stden & Eachday

From Last 3 yayrans. I stolen 70 oo A day over

This 3 yayrans. total a mount of money that I stolen is the last of the property by Not Ring.

Customers of orders and when work you work was man Ticket.

I have work for ********** 10 years.

Over the last 3 3 / 4 years I have stealing money from the till. I have stolen each day.

I worked 3 3 / 4 years. I stolen \$70.00 a day over this 3 3 / 4 years. total amount of money that I stolen is \$86,150.00. I stolen money by not ring customers orders and not ring customers meal ticket.

I have worked for ******* 10 years. Over the last 3 3 / 4 years I have been stealing money from the till. I have stolen every day that I worked. I have stolen an average of \$70.00 a day during this time. Total amount of money that I have stolen is \$84,260.00. I stole money by not ringing customers orders for danish, coffee, muffins. I would also save receipts from customers who wouldn't wait for them. And when a customer used a ******* meal ticket I would attach one of these receipts to the ticket and take the difference in the money. For example if a customer bought \$3.00 worth of food I would take a receipt for another \$2.00 or \$3.00 from the collection of receipts I had next to my register from previous sales and make it appear as if the customer had bought \$5.00 worth of food instead of \$3.00. I would put the \$2.00 in my purse which I kept underneath the register. I never stole over \$100.00 in one day. The last time I stole was today 8-22-90. Throughout the day I stole \$67.47. I stole this money by not ringing sales and by using the ******** ticket method.

After I stole this money I put it directly into my purse. I returned the stolen money from today to Mr. Urban which was 1 ten dollar bill, 6 five dollar bills, 23 one dollar bills, and \$4.47 in change. This money was photocopied and I have signed the photocopies of this money. The reason I stole the money over the past few years was to make the following payments: house, water, NSP, phone, trash, baby formula and diapers, social events, gas for car, on the average \$500.00 a month for grooeries.

My house payment is about \$400.00 a month. Another reason is that for the last 10-15 years my husband has not worked so I am the only one bringing in money. My husband was wondering where the extra money was coming from and I told him it was tips. When I first started at *********** within the first week after I started another cashier showed me how for steal money, and I have been doing it ever since.

******** have been stealing money the same way I have. ******* has been stealing for about one year. ******* has been stealing for about three years.

Sometimes ******* would put money from a sale she didn't ring up into an envelope and afterwards split it with me. The envelope with the stolen money was placed between the registers.

would total she would subtotal it up and ask the person if they wanted a receipt. If they wouldn't want it then she would ring it up as a ******** employee and then keep the money and start on the next person in line. It would make it appear that the first sale would be part of the second sale. She would put the money from the second sale into register and keep money from the first sale. She would then sign someones name on receipt.

I feel guilty. I just won't do it again. I will never do it again. I want to keep my job. If it was possible I would be willing to pay back \$84,280.00 out of my checks.
